Qualifications:

For subjects 1 to 33, candidates should possess at least a bachelor's degree from a recognised tertiary institution and for subjects 34 to 55, candidates should possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate or passes in at least two subjects obtained on one Certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" and a Certificate in the relevant field from a recognised institution acceptable to the Board.

In addition, all applicants should:

- a) be MQA registered and should reckon at least two years' training/teaching experience in their field of interest.
- b) produce written evidence of qualifications/experience claimed.
- c) be available to serve on an 'as and when required' basis; and
- d) submit copy of a Certificate of Character or produce same at the time of interview.
